

FILM FEST 2019

Engaging Faith, Minds and Community

The theme for Film Fest 2019 celebrates what makes our Catholic schools special, our point of difference aligning with the Catholic Schools Week (CSW) theme for 2019.

Film Fest will feature as one of the four pillars of the 'Catholic Schools Cultural Festival' and the finalists will be celebrated with a Recognition Award. Finalists' entries will be screened at this event.

Process

- The competition is open to all System school students.
- School Principals will choose the top entry from their school.
- Principals will submit the entries to the CEO via a Google form provided.
- The deadline for submissions is Friday, 26 July 2019
- A judging panel will select the top three from the submitted Finalists' films.
- Winning films will be screened at the Catholic Schools Cultural Festival in August at the reception following the Recognition Awards.
- Post event, the CE Communications and Marketing team will promote winning entry's across CE Social media and other digital platforms.

Technical Specifications

- The films must be less than three minutes in length.
- 16:9 aspect ratio.
- 1080p high definition video (minimum).
- MP4 file format.

Finalists Judging Panel

We recommend that the finalist judging panel be comprised of:

- Vicar of Education, Monsignor John Woods
- CE Deputy Director, Angus Tulley
- Principal Catholic Identity Officer, Paddy McGrath

The Judging Panel will provide recommendations to the Director.

Judging Categories

- ACT and NSW Primary
- ACT and NSW Secondary

Selection Criteria

1. Creativity demonstrated:
 - Storyline and link to the theme: *Engaging Faith, Minds and Community*.
 - Music, effects, other creative ideas.
2. Production Quality
 - Design and use of set and costumes.
 - Quality of final film and its presentation.
3. Technology
 - Use of drones, green screens, etc.
 - Animation.
 - Other applications (special effects like stop motion, time lapse etc.).
